

Quality Award for PhD students of the 28th cycle of the PhD program in Computer and Control Engineering

Based on the rules defined by SCUDO, the Academic Board of the PhD program in Computer and Control Engineering launched an evaluation procedure to select the 5 winners of a Quality Award, to be selected among the PhD students enrolled to the 28th cycle. Each award consists of a 1,200 € prize and a certificate.

The selection will be done based on the following parameters

1. Scientific production
2. Training activity, including both the learning activities (e.g., PhD courses, tutorials, summer schools, visits to other research centers) and the teaching activities (if the PhD student played an active role in any course of Politecnico di Torino, he/she should also provide information about the student evaluations gathered by CPD)
3. Research and technology transfer projects (e.g., projects with industries or supported by public bodies)
4. Awards and recognitions (including also the possible participation to the program or organizing committee of any scientific event).

Students can nominate themselves for the award by sending an e-mail message to the address *phd-dauin@polito.it*. A CV including all relevant information with respect to the above parameters and a Publication List, including all papers published or officially accepted must be attached to the message as pdf files. The message must be sent by October 4 at the latest.

The identification of the 5 awardees will be done by the Academic Board of the PhD program in Computer and Control Engineering by October 15 based on the information provided by the nominees in the above message, only. The awards related to all PhD programs of Politecnico di Torino will be presented at a ceremony that will be held on November 10.
